

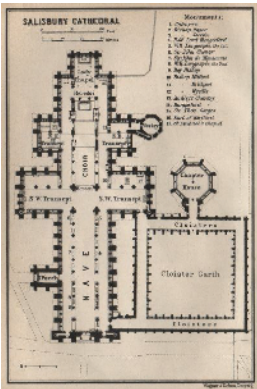
Church on the Corner Weekend Away 2018

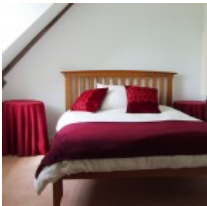


We will be exploring the theme and practice of retreat. Sessions will be a blend of teaching, practical and discussion, and we will join in with worship at Salisbury Cathedral.

Trains run from Waterloo direct to Salisbury in 1 hour 30 minutes. Train tickets to Salisbury can be bought in advance for £18 return (book your train ASAP - the cheapest tickets don't last long). It is a short walk from the Railway station to Sarum College.
